

DRAMA: JESUS WALKS

Type: Roopu Rangatahi Activity
Author: Te Māra Rangatahi Ministry School
Date: July 2007

Aim: to give rangatahi an insight into the life and ministry of Jesus, and to increase their knowledge of Jesus

Delivery:

Go through the PowerPoint Bible Study with the roopu. Begin with a discussion on what Jesus looked like, comparing the three pictures. On the left is an ancient Africa depiction of Jesus, centre is an archaeological recreation and right is a LDS (Mormon) depiction. This is to think about our understandings of who Jesus was.

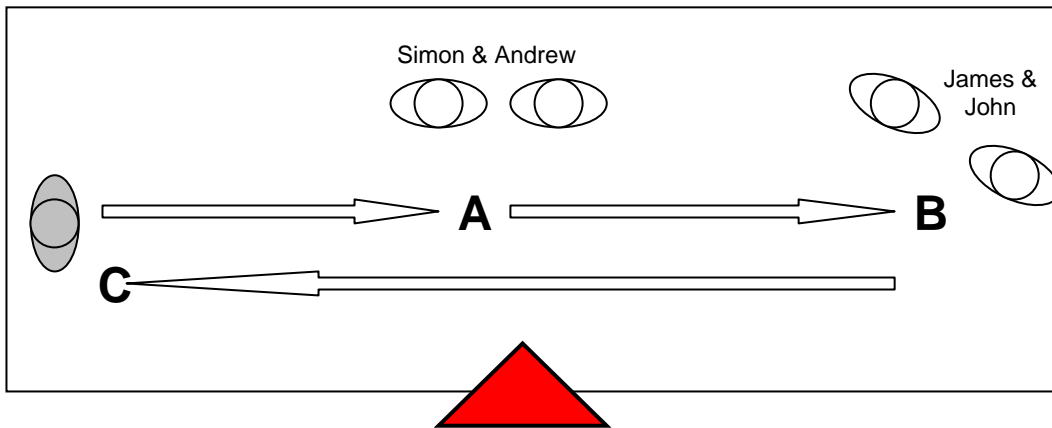
Next, get a rangatahi to do each reading and there are some short discussion questions to consider.

Then in groups, prepare and rehearse sections, using the video as a possible guide and level for improvement.

Calling the Fishermen



Prop: Net

Script

Jesus was walking along the shore of ***Lake Galilee***, when he saw Simon and his brother Andrew. They were fishermen, and they were casting their nets into the lake [*A. throw net*]

Jesus said to them, "Come with me! I will teach you how fish for people."

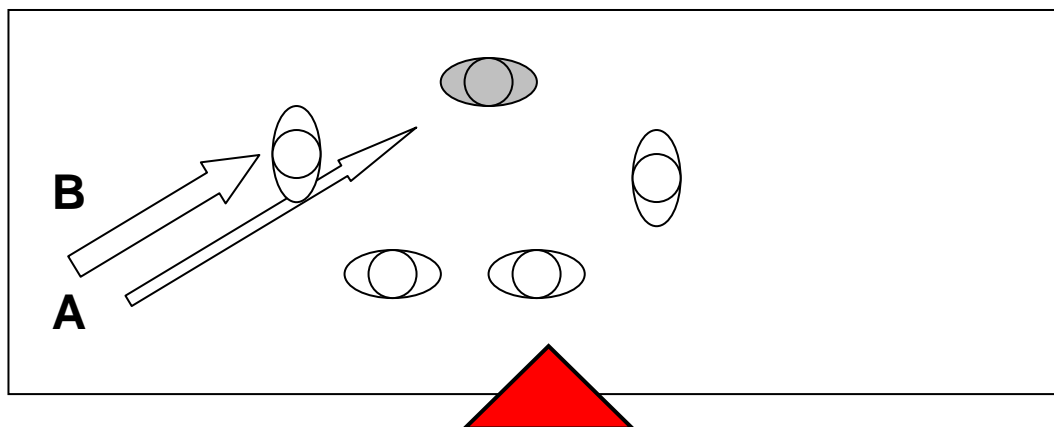
Right then the two brothers dropped their nets and went with him. [*drop net and follow*]

Jesus walked on and soon saw James and John, the sons of Zebedee. They were in a boat, mending their nets. Jesus asked them to come with him. They left their father in the boat with the hired workers and went with him. [*B. drop net and follow C.*]

Script

Jesus walked up on **a hill** and sat down. [*A. walk and sit down*]
His followers came to him, [*B. walk and sit down*] and he began to teach them, saying:

"Those who are humble are happy, because the earth will belong to them.
Those who want to do right more than anything else are happy, because God will fully satisfy them.

Those who work to bring peace are happy, because God will call them his children."

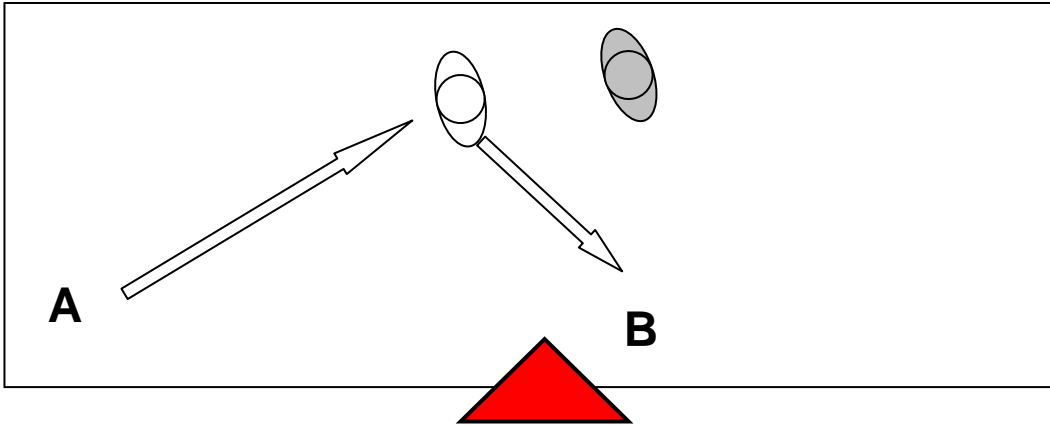

Prop: Bandages

Script

As Jesus was walking, a leper came to Him. He fell to his knees and begged Jesus, "You can heal me if you will." [*A. kneel and beg*]

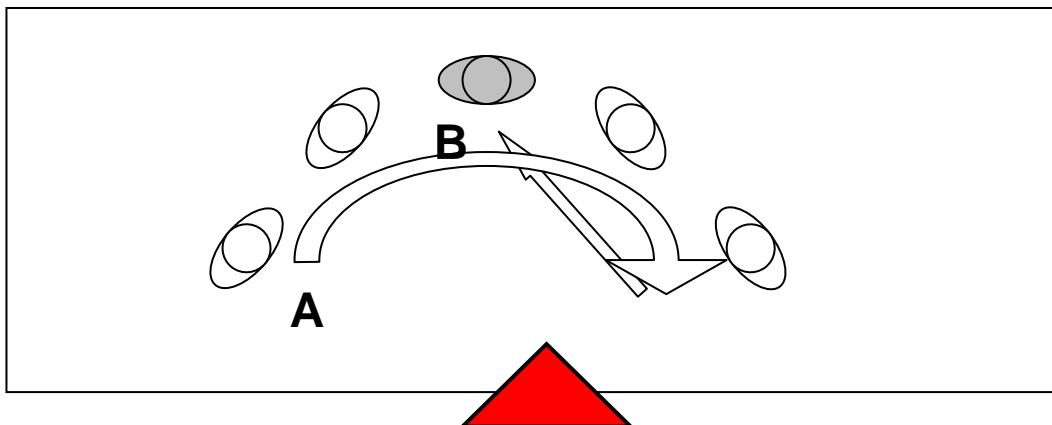
Jesus felt sorry for the man, so he reached out his hand and touched him and said, "I will. Be healed!" Immediately the disease left the man, and he was healed. [*drop bandages*]

Jesus told the man to go away at once, but he warned him strongly, "Don't tell anyone about this." The man left there, but he began to tell everyone that Jesus had healed him, and so he spread the news about Jesus. [*B. wave arms*]

The Last Supper



Prop: Towel, Bread and Wine

Script

At the end of their walking, Jesus and his followers met for a meal. During the meal Jesus began to wash the followers' feet, drying them with the towel. *[A. wash and dry all feet B.]*

While they were eating, Jesus took some bread and thanked God for it and broke it. Then he gave it to his followers and said, "Take, eat; this is my body." *[break bread]*

Then Jesus took a cup and thanked God for it and gave it to the followers, and they all drank from the cup. Then Jesus said, "This is my blood which is the new agreement that God makes with his people. This blood is poured out for many." *[pass cup]*

After supper Jesus said to them, "I give you a new command: Love one another. You must love one another as I have loved you."
